

Privacy Policy - National Institute of Health Carlos III

The National Institute of Health Carlos III (ISCIII), is a public institution dependent of the Spanish Ministries of Health and Science. The ISCIII acts as the coordinator of the ERA PerMed project, so it's in charge of guaranteeing a correct data management during all the project extension. This privacy policy will explain how our organization uses the personal data we collect from you when you use our website or apply to join to one of our events.

1) What data do we collect?

Our institution collects the following data:

- Personal identification information (Title, name, email, etc.)
- Information about the institution of origin (name of institution, country, etc.)
- Information related to the ERA PerMed project (participation in related initiatives, role in the project, participation from a third-party, etc.)

2) How do we collect your data?

You directly provide our institution with most of the data we collect. We collect and process data when you:

- Register online for our newsletter or one of our events.
- Access to the private area in the website.
- Use or view our website via your browser's cookies.

Our institution may also receive your data indirectly from the following sources, when you:

- Subscribe to follow our Twitter account, or do a comment to one of our posts.

3) How will we use your data?

Our institution collects your data so that we can:

- Email you with a newsletter including the latest activities within the trimester.
- Manage your account and your activities in the private area.
- Ensure you can access to our events after your registration.

- Obtain statistics about the impact that our dissemination strategy has had during the life of the project.

Our institution may share your data with our partners in the project, so that they may obtain statistical data about the impact of the ERA PerMed initiative. Only the consortium partners, listed as NSCs, shall receive these data.

4) How do we store your data?

Our institution securely stores your data at its own servers. They are managed by our own informatics support service (UTIC).

Our institution will keep your data until the end of the project, and after until the end of the two years that are mandatory by the European Commission (EC).

5) Marketing

Our institution would like to send you information about our latest activities through our newsletter. Also we may inform you about other related events from other initiatives as the ICP Consortium or the EULAC PerMed project.

If you have agreed to receive our newsletter, you may always opt out at a later date.

You have the right at any time to stop our institution from contacting you.

6) What are your data protection rights?

Our institution would like to make sure you are fully aware of all of your data protection rights. Every user is entitled to the following:

The right to access – You have the right to request our institution for copies of your personal data. We may charge you a small fee for this service.

The right to rectification – You have the right to request that our institution correct any information you believe is inaccurate. You also have the right to request our institution to complete information you believe is incomplete.

The right to erasure – You have the right to request that our institution erase your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to restrict processing – You have the right to request that our institution restrict the processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to object to processing – You have the right to object to our institution's processing of your personal data, under certain conditions.

The right to data portability – You have the right to request that our institution transfer the data that we have collected to another organization, or directly to you, under certain conditions.

7) What are cookies?

Cookies are text files placed on your computer to collect standard Internet log information and visitor behavior information. When you visit our website, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

8) How do we use cookies?

Our institution uses cookies in a range of ways to improve your experience on our website, including:

- Keeping you signed in when you access to the private area.
- Understanding how you use our website.
- Preventing unauthorized access to the private area.

9) What types of cookies do we use?

There are a number of different types of cookies, however, our website uses:

- **Functionality** – Our institution uses these cookies so that we recognize you on our website and remember your previously selected preferences. These could include what language you prefer and location you are in. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies is used.
- **Advertising** – Our institution uses these cookies to collect information about your visit to our website, the content you viewed, the links you followed and information about your browser, device, and your IP address. These cookies are linked to the services provided by Google and Twitter. We don't share any direct content with them, just the data they collect through their cookies in our website.

10) How to manage cookies

You can set your browser not to accept cookies, and the above website tells you how to remove cookies from your browser. However, in a few cases, some of our website features may not function as a result (for example, the access to the private area).

11) Privacy policies of other websites

The ERA PerMed website contains links to other websites. Our privacy policy applies only to our website, so if you click on a link to another website, you should read their privacy policy.

12) Changes to our privacy policy

Our institution keeps its privacy policy under regular review and places any updates on this web page. This privacy policy was last updated on 4 February 2021.
